He is currently employed as the Senior Animator for FOX Television in Chicago where he works seamlessly across various technologies and mediums such as print, video and interactive media.

With over 25 years of experience in Television Broadcasting, he has worked as a Broadcast Engineer, Graphic Designer, Motion Graphics Artist; and 3D modeler and Animator, gaining first hand experience in the technical and artistic aspects of the converging fields. His skill set focuses on the ever-changing advances in visual communication software and technologies in order to best convey effective branding and stimulating messages using video, motion graphics and 3D modeling and animation.
